If a person quits work, he or she is not considered a dislocated worker even if that person receives unemployment benefits.

As of today, are either of your parents (dependent student) or student/spouse (independent student) a dislocated worker? Please review the following criteria and if yes, submit the required documentation.

A person may be considered a dislocated worker if he or she:

\_\_\_\_\_ has been terminated, laid off, or received a termination or layoff and are unlikely to return to your usual occupation or industry because of:

- A permanent plant closure
- A substantial layoff
- Foreign competition
- Lack of demand for your skills

\_\_\_\_\_ was self employed but now unemployed due to economic conditions or natural disaster; (Examples include farmers, ranchers, fishermen etc,)

\_\_\_\_\_ is-a displaced homemaker. A displaced homemaker is a person who previously provided unpaid services to the family (e.g., a stay- at-home mom or dad) is no longer supported by the husband or wife, is unemployed or underemployed, and is having trouble finding or upgrading employment.

3. Copy of certification showing that your parent (dependent students) or you/spouse (independent students) are classified a Dislocated Worker. You can become certified as eligible at any Work Source Career Center or Employment Security Commission in your state of residence.
