School of Government faculty member Greg Allison will offer a workshop for budget and finance officers, managers and others with responsibilities in municipal and county finance. The six-hour program will be useful for independent auditors who work with governmental clients as well.

Workshop sessions will highlight current issues in the governmental accounting and auditing environment. There will be an overview of current GAAP accounting and reporting issues, with a focus on a GASB Update that will include the continuing impact of OPEB, new guidance related to the evolving definitions of governmental fund types and fund balance, as well as a review of common governmental accounting and financial reporting problems and challenges.

The workshop is co-sponsored by the Local Government Training Program, in the Department of Political Science and Public Affairs at Western Carolina University.
