1. Approval of minutes from the November 18, 2011 meeting:

2. Discussion of ULP issues from last meeting:

The committee reaffirmed the ULP decision that was made during the November 18, 2011 meeting and a motion was made to allow Carol and Steve to make exemptions on a case-by-case basis dealing with students who change their major. The motion passed by unanimous vote.
