McLaughlin is the author of a number of publications on tax listing, assessing and collections. His comprehensive new book, *Fundamentals of Property Tax Collection Law in North Carolina*, will be available for purchase at the seminar.

Attendees will earn six hours of NCTCA continuing education credit. Note that collectors may not receive credit for this seminar if they also take McLaughlin's School of Government tax collection course in March 2012.
