3. List grants submitted and the amount requested in funding.
4. List grants awarded and the amount of each funding.
5. List research studies undertaken by the center.
6. List publications addressing center research/initiatives.
7. List promotional materials/newsletters created by the center (provide samples).
8. Provide a copy of the most recent evaluation of center (not director) by supervisor.
9. List innovative programs created to support teachers of Western North Carolina including those to meet license renewal requirements.
10. Discuss the use of technology to further the unit's service mission.
11. Discuss the Reading Center in the context of the BKEMGE Department's mission.
