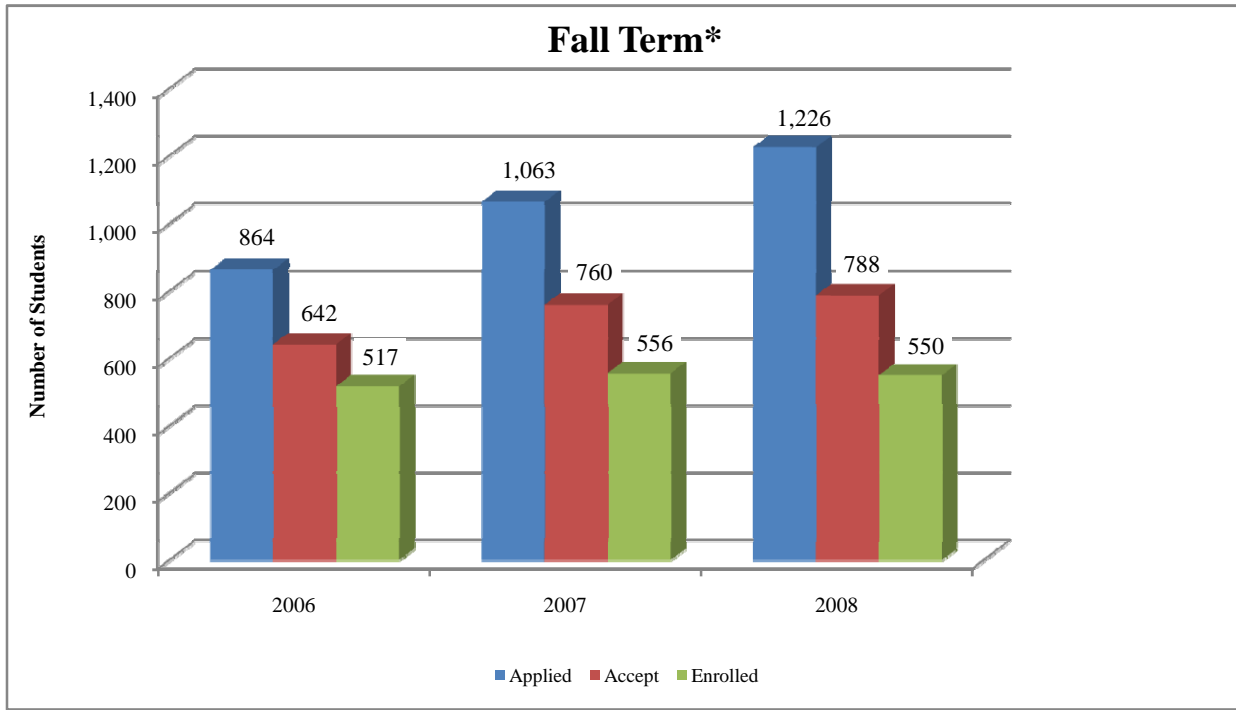

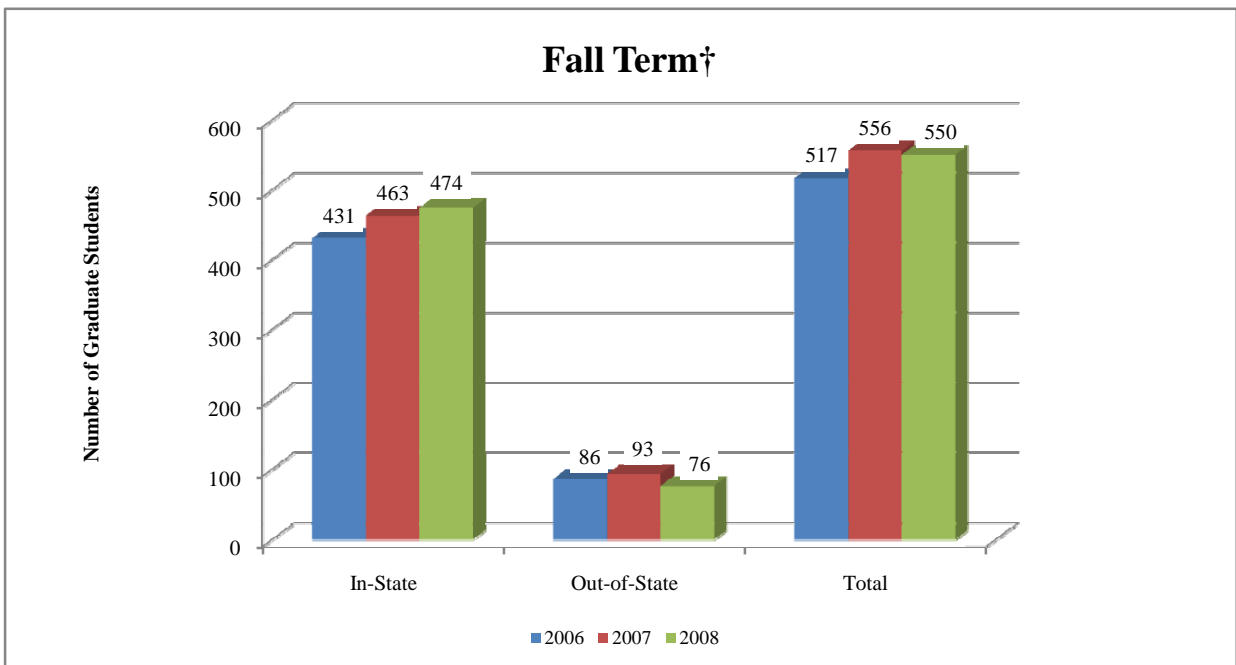
## Graduate Applicants and Enrollees

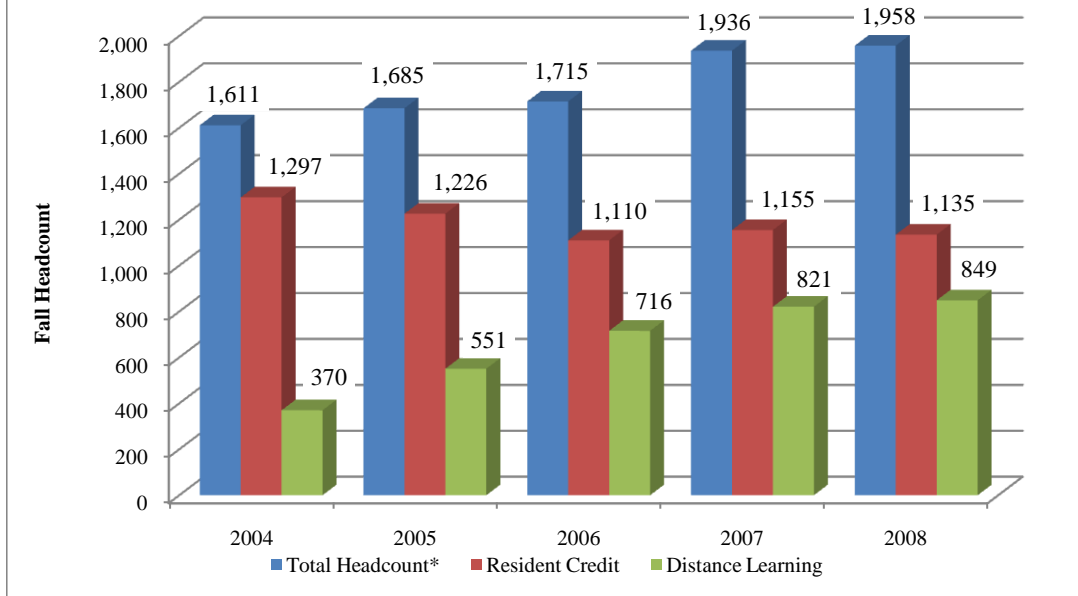

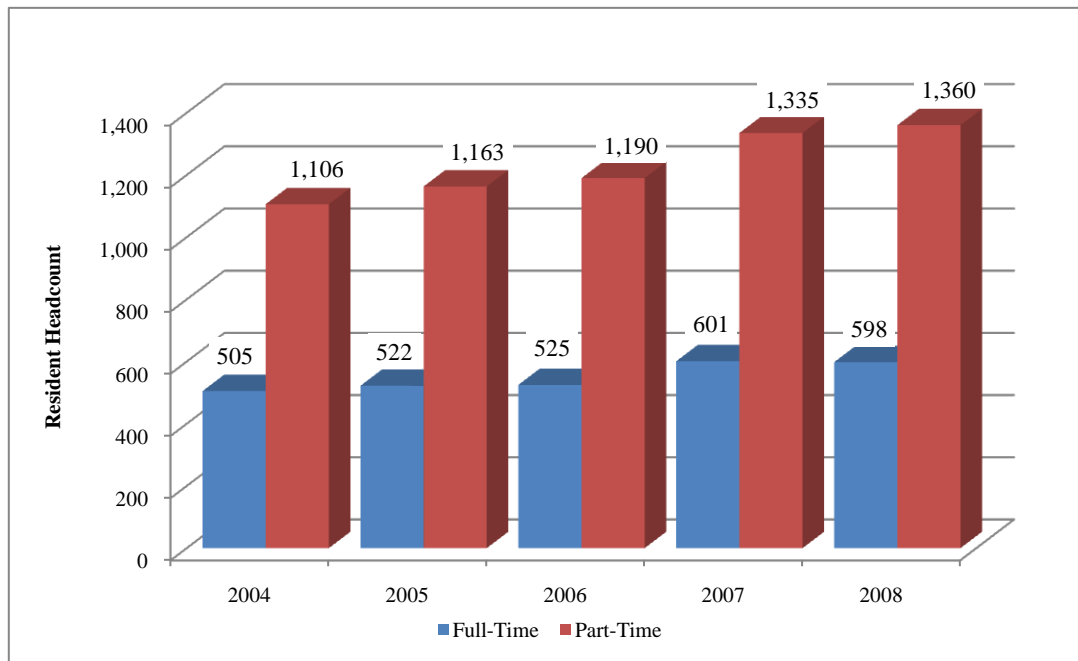
## Graduate Headcount Enrollment



\*Total Headcount does not equal the sum of Distance Learning and Resident Credit Headcount because some students are enrolled in both resident credit and distance learning credit courses.

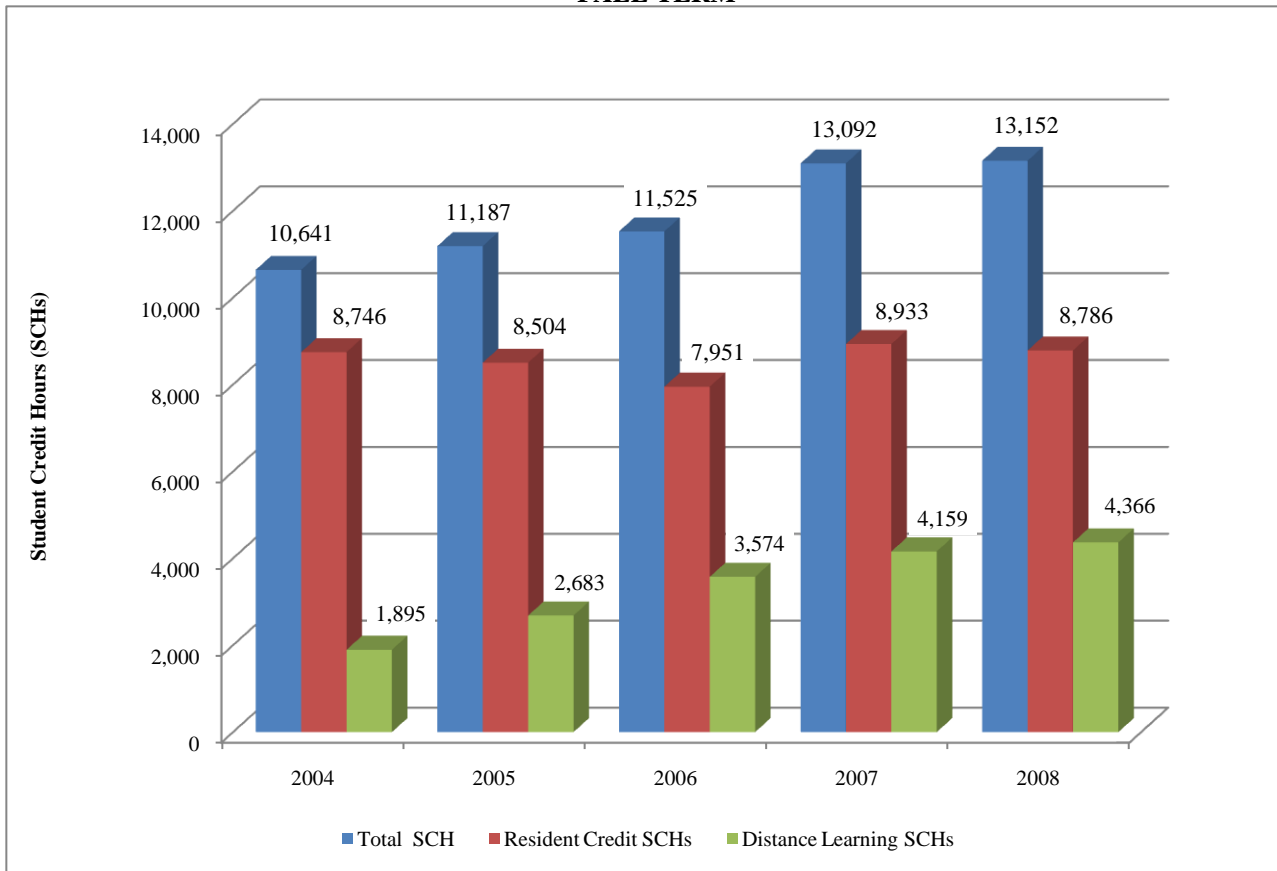
