FAQ

When must my registration be *received* by The Honors College?

The registration form with check must be received no later than **Friday, September 16**. If you can fax the form earlier, please do so, but the original form and check for payment must be received by the 16th.

Can I pay with a credit card?

No. Unfortunately we can only accept checks.

What should I wear at the conference?

The Banquet and Semi-formal Dance will be “professional dress” on Friday evening. All events on Saturday will be casual (you will receive a conference T-shirt to wear). Check the weather report for umbrella/rain gear/jacket.

Where should I stay on Friday night?

Faculty/staff must arrange for rooms off campus (check the website for lodging options). Student attendees have the option of being hosted on campus with WCU Honors students with similar major and/or hometown at no charge (think slumber party) or staying off campus at an area motel.

What else should I bring if I will be staying with a host in a student room?

Please watch your email as listed on the registration form for communications from your host. Besides your clothes and cell phone, you will most likely need a pillow and quilt, towel, and, of course, all your toiletries.
