School of Government Professor Rich Ducker will lead a workshop focused on the interests of local governments when land is proposed for subdivision.

Designed for planners, managers, and planning and governing board members, the workshop's morning session will cover reviewing subdivision proposals, understanding regulatory issues affecting plat review and thinking through the provision of common or public improvements.

The afternoon design session led by Luther Smith, RLA, and Anne Valentine, RLA, president and vice president of Luther E. Smith & Associates, PA, will discuss land planning and design for residential development, including conservation design. The program will conclude with a panel discussion with Q & A.

The workshop is co-sponsored by the Local Government Training Program, in the Department of Political Science and Public Affairs at Western Carolina University and the Western Regional Office of the Division of Community Assistance, in the NC Department of Commerce.
