Notice seeking proposals for planning grants (workshops, conferences, symposia, and related short-term activities), Track I (proof-of-concept) projects, and Track II (full-scale projects) projects to increase participation in the geosciences by African Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans (American Indians and Alaskan Natives), Native Pacific Islanders (Polynesians or Micronesians), and persons with disabilities. A secondary goal of the program is to increase the perceived relevance of the geosciences among broad and diverse segments of the population.

ACTION:
Letters of intent are required and due by November 11, 2008. Track I and Track II proposals are due by December 11, 2008. Planning Grant proposals are due by May 1 and November 3, 2009. Approximately \$9.2 million is available to support 42 awards in FYs 09 and 10.

LIMITED COMPETITION: 1 Track II application as lead applicant per institution.
