**Applications are accepted at any time throughout the year, but are only reviewed the 15<sup>th</sup> of every month for exhibit the following month. Exhibit themes are curated by the UC Showroom Staff, but suggestions are welcome. Proposals may be submitted on behalf of an entire studio class.**

Artists interested in exhibition at the UC Showroom must include the following in their application packet. All materials can be sent in either hard copy and included on CD, or via email. If your art work is accepted for a show, you will be informed at least 2 weeks in advance.

- A cover letter containing a clear and concise proposal for your exhibition
  
- 5-10 images of your work
  
- contact sheet (with image information: dimensions, media, date created and price or NFS)
  
- Artist's Statement
  
- A self addressed stamped envelope for the return of your application materials. Or, if you would like to pick them up from the UC office, please specify.

## **THE FACILITY**

The UC Showroom space for changing exhibitions consists of a small room 24' x 11'. The Showroom is on the second floor of the University Center and used to be a coffee shop. The room is equipped with track lighting, two cases for small sculpture or ceramics 24 x 24 x38 with the vitrine height at 43" and 26 x 46 x38 with a vitrine height of 43," and steel track rods to display and hang wall art. No exhibit work can be nailed to the walls. The Showroom cannot be painted. For security, the cases are drilled shut. There are two security cameras on both sides of the hall in front of the Showroom. The University Center is locked every night at closing time. Students will not be responsible for installing work. The UC tech specialist will install work.

Entry to the showroom implies agreement on the part of the sender to the conditions set forth by the University Center.
