

WRITING CENTER INFORMATION

SPRING: Through the end of spring semester, the Writing Center will offer tutoring as usual, from **9:00 to 5:00**. We will operate from our current location (main floor in Hunter Library) with no changes in service.

MINI-MESTER: The Writing Center will not offer tutoring during the mini-mester. (Students with special or emergency tutoring needs are still encouraged to contact us, however.) We will use this time to merge with the CAT Center (30 Hunter Library).

FIRST SUMMER SESSION: Beginning June 1, the Writing Center will merge with the CAT Center, and most tutoring sessions will be held there. Writing tutoring will be available from **12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.**, and/or by appointment.

SECOND SUMMER SESSION: During second summer session, the Writing Center will offer tutoring from **1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.** Most tutoring sessions will be held in the CAT Center.

Although much tutoring will be held in the CAT Center after June 1st, the Writing Center's current location (on the main floor of the library) will continue to be part of both centers. It will be used as a resource room for group conferences, special class visits, presentations, and multiple individual appointments.

The Writing Center staff members are excited about the improved opportunities that come with this merger. We look forward to expanding our resources and facilities, and we are committed to providing consistent, reliable writing assistance to the entire campus.
