

Wiffle Ball Rules

All baseball rules are in effect except for the following:

1. Bases shall be 50 feet apart. Pitcher's rubber will be 32 feet from home plate. There is no "out of play."
2. Five players will be on the field at a time. An extra hitter (EH) may be used so you may bat up to six players. Any five players may play in the field as long as the batting order stays the same. Maximum of eight players per roster.
3. Games will be seven innings or 55 minutes, no new inning will begin after 50 minutes.
4. To record an out, the ball may be caught in the air, the base or runner tagged, or the batter/runner may be struck with the ball before they reach base.
5. The home run line will be 100 feet (this is subject to change). Any ball that lands across the line in the air is a homerun. Any ball in the air may be caught across the line for an out. Any ball that hits the ground then rolls across is in play.
6. A stationary strike zone will be behind the plate. Any ball that hits in this box, no matter where it crosses the plate, is a strike.
7. The batter starts with no balls and no strikes. There are unlimited foul balls. **NO BUNTING!**
8. The runner may lead off of the base, but must be stationary once the pitcher releases the ball and until the ball crosses the plate. If the umpire judges the runner is in motion, they will be called out. The runner may be picked off by the pitcher. **No Stealing.**
9. Pitches will be overhand. Pitches cannot reach excessive speeds. The hitter reserves the right to call "HEAT" on such pitches. These pitches will be replayed. The umpire will be the final word on such conflicts.
10. All Intramural eligibility rules apply.
