





#### DEGREES CONFERRED 2022-23







# **NC PROMISE** NCPROMISE.WCU.EDU

NC Promise is a guaranteed tuition reduction program for undergraduate students at WCU that lowers tuition to \$500 per semester for in-state students and \$2500 for all other undergraduate students. NC Promise was initiated as a legislative action for four participating public universities in North Carolina to increase access to higher education, improve affordability, reduce student debt and continue to grow North Carolina's economy. With NC Promise, an in-state student who earns a WCU degree in four years saves approximately \$12,000 towards the total cost of their college degree. Campus-related fees for students and on-campus residency fees are an additional cost, but NC Promise has delivered on its intent to combat the cost of college and has made WCU a national leader in college affordability.

The Catamount Commitment is a transparent, easy to understand student aid program offered by WCU. Catamount Commitment provides first-time North Carolina college students who meet the published criteria a defined four-year financial award. One of the most frequent comments from families of aspiring college students is that they wish they knew up front how much financial aid their student could expect to receive as they plan for college. Catamount Commitment helps address that perennial family question.

Catamount Commitment invests in North Carolina students, encourages and incentivizes them to Finish in Four, limits or eliminates college debt and helps students earn competitive credentials for graduate school or career choices. Coupled with NC Promise, Catamount Commitment continues to position WCU as an affordable and high-quality university value.

#### **Our Catamount Commitment:**

- » Funding for fall and spring semesters for eligible first-year students (read Terms and Conditions\*)
- » Award levels that stack on top of NC Promise savings to help address tuition, fees, room and board
- » Renewability of the award-level commitment for students who honor their commitment
- » Four-year support that can carry into WCU graduate studies for those who graduate early
