

Who is Lilly Ledbetter and Why Do I Care?

The Lilly Ledbetter Fair Play Act is the first law enacted in the Obama administration and may represent sweeping changes in compensation litigation and lead to a dramatic increase in such cases. Other changes include executive compensation limitations, the new COBRA rules, and the McCaskill whistleblower law, all of which are contained in the recently enacted federal stimulus legislation, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. Do you understand how this will affect your organization?
