Course Fee: \$700 per two-week course

Course Credit Fee: \$115 per course (subject to change), charged only to students who register for credit through either UNC-Chapel Hill or Western Carolina University. Courses may be taken without credit, but preference is given to degree seeking students enrolled for credit.

Housing Fee: \$150-\$250 per course, depending on accommodations.
