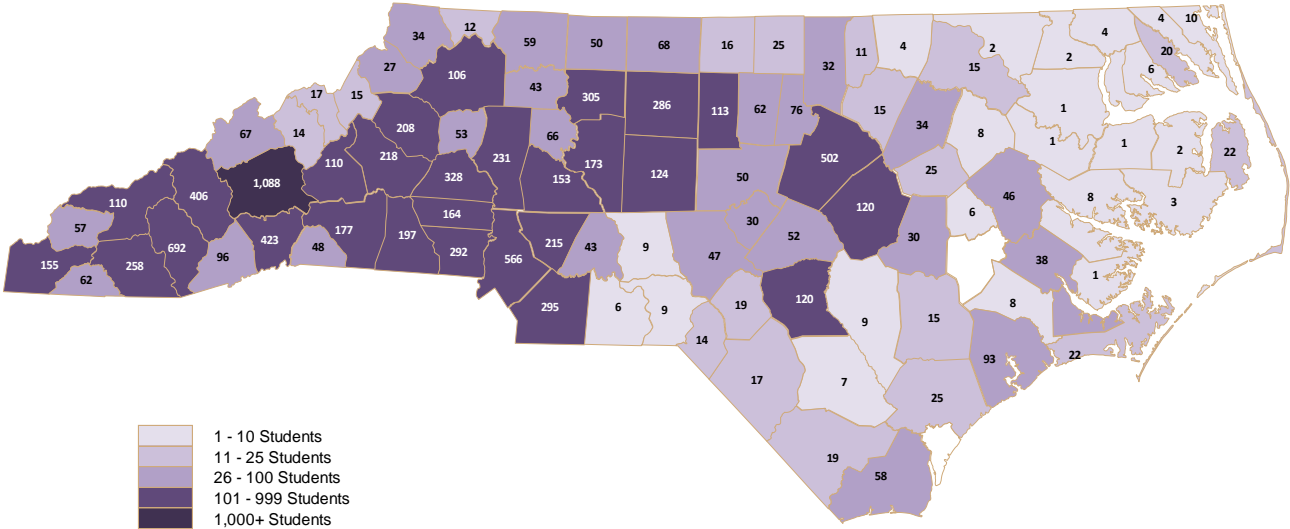

Geographic Distribution of Students

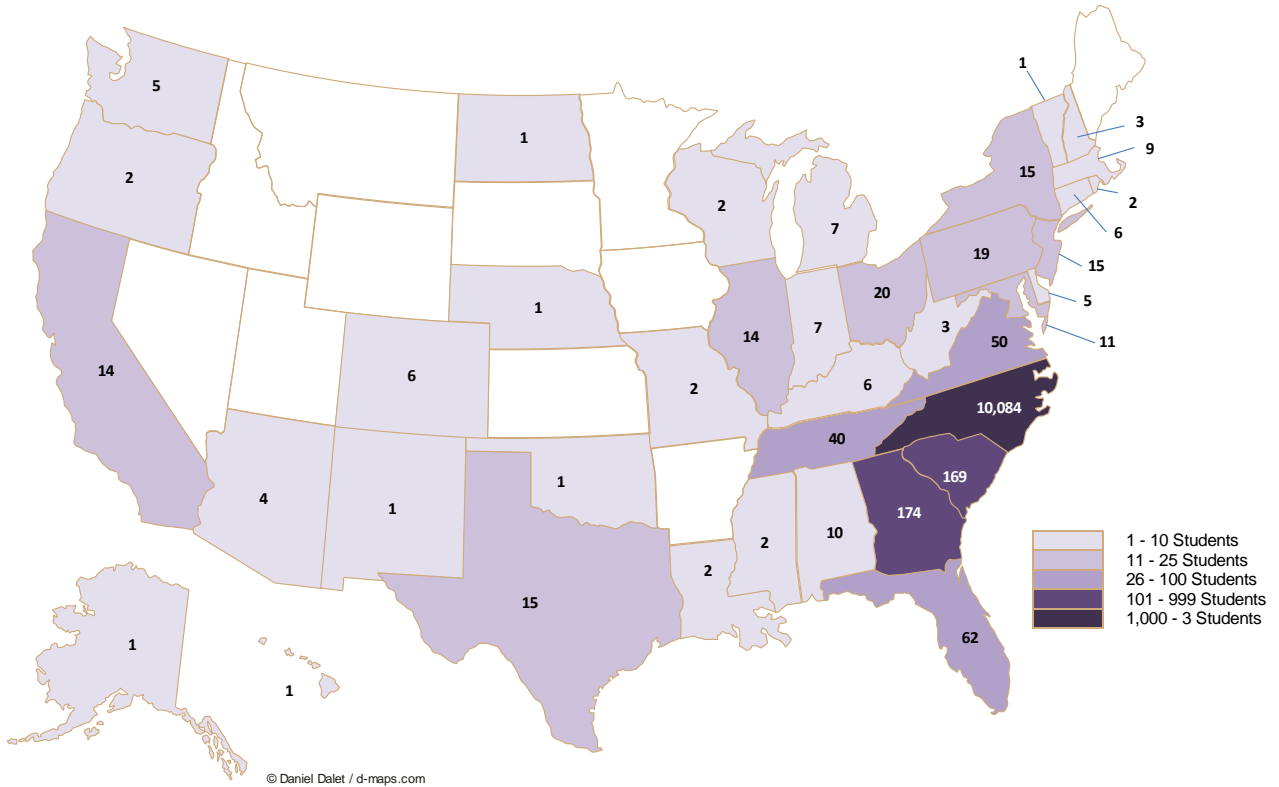

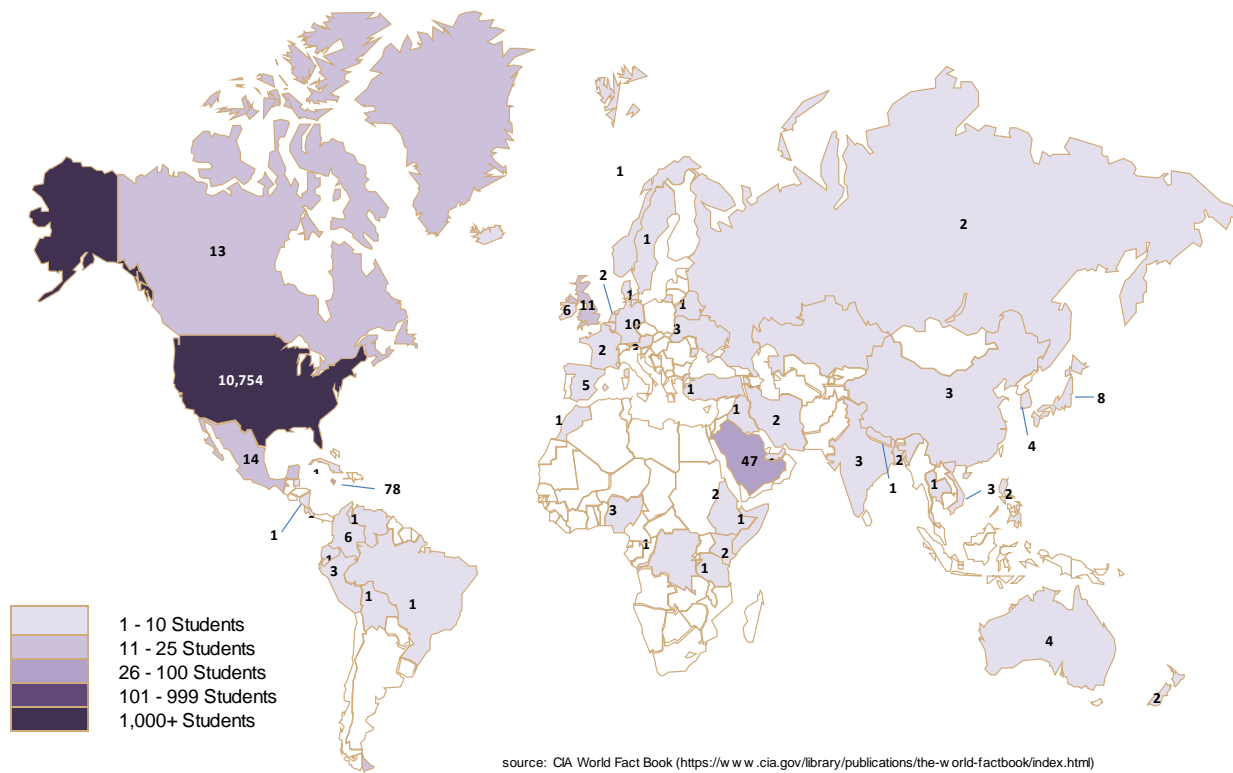
Total Enrollment by State
