

Copy your video from an iOS device to your computer

This should work for iPhones and iPads. This is one way to do it with a Windows computer that you have not synced to before:

1. Start iTunes on your computer
2. Make sure your iOS device is turned on and plug it in to the computer via the USB cable
3. iTunes will prompt if you want to connect to the device. Click yes or OK whichever you see.
4. The iOS device will prompt you if you want to trust the connection to this computer. Touch "Trust"
5. The computer may indicate it is installing drivers. Let it finish that process before proceeding. It may take several minutes.
6. Unplug your iOS device from the computer. Wait about 10 seconds, and plug it back in.
7. Wait a few seconds until iTunes recognizes your iOS device again.
8. Open File Explorer in Windows. You should now see a folder for your iOS device that will look like a flash drive
9. Double-click the icon for the iOS device. Go into the DCIM folder. In here, you should find the videos you have recorded. You may need to dig through them and through subfolders to find them.
10. Once you find the videos, you can right-click on a video you want, select Copy, then go to your computer's desktop (or wherever you want to save the video) and right click and Paste.
11. Depending on the size of your video, it may take several minutes to copy.
