

# HAZARDOUS WASTE STORAGE

## COMPATIBLE WASTE CONTAINER:

Collect waste in a clean, leak-proof, container that is compatible with the waste material. Do not use beakers, flasks, or household containers to collect waste. Do not fill containers completely, leave at least 10% headspace to allow for expansion.

## SECONDARY CONTAINMENT:

Store waste bottles in a secondary bin or tray to capture any spills from overpour or breakage! Segregate incompatible waste streams. Check containers regularly to ensure they are in good condition.



**LID:** Use a secure fitting lid and keep the container closed at all times. Allow chemicals to react completely & cool to ambient temperature before adding to waste container. Use vented caps when necessary.

**LABEL:** The label or waste tag must include the words “Hazardous Waste” and include the following elements:

- Full chemical name (no formulas) for all components.
- Concentration (% , M, etc.) each
- Amount (mass or volume) each
- Generator name and location
- Start date of accumulation, (when waste is first added).
