A VIRTUAL Opportunity for PreK-12 Education Majors Spring Semester 2021

Apply to participate in the twentieth-annual Rural-Urban Exchange, a collaborative undertaking involving the College of Education and Allied Professions (CEAP) at WCU and the School of Education at North Carolina Agricultural & Technical State University (NC A&T SU) in Greensboro. Eight students from WCU and eight from NC A&T SU will be selected to participate.

This year's program will be VIRTUAL. WCU participants will:

- participate in one virtual training seminar in February
- participate in several additional virtual planning meetings with your home campus co-participants and faculty in February and March
- work together with your home campus co-participants in late February to create a toolkit of resources for urban or rural schooling to provide to your partner campus
- engage independent reflections, journal-writing, and video-watching
- participate in 3-5 virtual, day-time virtual meetings with partner campus co-participants in March (you will be excused from class)

The program is available to all teacher-education students at WCU who:

- are admitted to the teacher education program, and
- NOT in full-time student teaching (Intern II) during Spring 2021.
