

SEI Meeting Minutes – 3/14/18

- Budget Update
 - We currently have \$62,078.05 in our account
 - Equinox (Cullowhee Creek Corridor) is contracted for \$50,000, and they can draw another \$37,000
 - So, we only really have about \$25,000
 - Campus Tree ID Project is also a cost share, which will knock us down to \$10,000
 - EGG maintenance could also cost us quite a bit
 - Our funding is pretty limited for this project proposal cycle
