

Pre-Physician Assistant

In order to become a physician assistant, you must:

- complete a bachelor's degree (in any major) <u>WCU Undergraduate Major Options</u>
- take the appropriate prerequisite coursework (see list of programs for specifics)
- take the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) <u>Examprep.wcu.edu</u>
- obtain required, paid clinical experience hours (see list of programs for specifics)
- apply through CASPA, some colleges may require additional applications Application Log-in
- complete the course of study in a PA program (~2 years) List of programs
- pass the Physician Assistant National Certifying Examination (PANCE) PANCE testing information
- obtain license from state where practice is located

What should I major in?

While there is no prescribed major for admission into a physician assistant program, it is imperative that students complete all required courses for admission. PA programs vary significantly in their requirements, and it is important for you to learn what coursework the schools that interest you require. Students should choose their major according to their strengths, interests and alternative career choices. The Centralized Application Service for Physician Assistants is used by the majority of PA schools but individual schools may also require a separate application to their institution as well.

Minimally, a student should complete these courses at WCU for entrance into many physical therapy programs:
