

Western Carolina University Athletics Annual Report to the Board of Trustees 2021-2022



Coming out of COVID and the impacts it had on the 2020-21 academic year, 2021-22 was full of excitement, especially welcoming back our fans to venues without restrictions. In the end, WCU Athletics accomplished five top three finishes with football and women's golf having big improvements from a year ago.

The Athletics department welcomed several new employees throughout the department including an entire new coaching staff in baseball. On June 10, 2022 former Catamount **Alan Beck** was named the 11<sup>th</sup> head baseball coach in Western Carolina University history. Beck has hit the ground running in recruiting new Catamounts, retaining the current roster, and establishing a staff.

With an annual operational budget of approximately \$13.3 million, Catamount Athletics employs 81 full-time staff members and shepherds 375 student-athletes. Below is a breakdown of our student-athletes by sport:

The following sports received perfect Single Year Academic Progress Rate (APR) scores during the previous 2020-21 academic year: men's cross country, men's golf, women's basketball, women's cross country, women's golf, softball, women's soccer, women's tennis, and volleyball. APR is a tool used to hold institutions accountable for the academic progress of their student-athletes through a team-based metric that accounts for the eligibility and retention of each student-athlete for each academic term.

## Capital Improvements

- ▶ Engaged MacMillan-Pazden-Smith as our selected firm for advance facility planning of the 2019 Athletics Facility Master Plan. In August, MPS will complete with planning process and deliver a sequencing plan for future construction. MPS has met with all coaches and senior staff to understand our needs now and in the future.
- ▶ Ramsey Center The bid for renovating the men's and women's basketball locker rooms as well as the video viewing room have been awarded. Renderings have been generated and the basketball teams are looking forward to their new homes. Construction is slated to start before the end of 2022.
- ▶ **Hennon Stadium** The baseball facility received some much-needed attention. The scoreboard has been replaced, artificial turf has been installed around home plate, the dugouts were upgraded with new benches, padding, lighting, and heat.
- ▶ Ramsey Center New courtside video boards, a fresh court resurfacing and hallway graphics were all brought in to enhance the game day experience for our volleyball and basketball teams. Plus, the auxiliary gym's court has been resurfaced with new goals to be installed this summer/fall.
- ► Catamount Complex As a result of a philanthropic gift, the soccer team has new sideline benches. The new larger shells allow the entire team to get out of the elements during matches.
- ➤ **Softball Facility** New and enhanced playing surfaces at the mound and around home plate make for more stable and durable infield

# **Community Service**

During the 2021-22 academic year, our student-athletes dedicated a significant number of time to community service. After the restrictions of 2020-21 and COVID, they were ready to get back into the community by reading to children at the library and opening doors for elementary school drop off. In total, student-athletes logged 955 hours of community service.

# Revenue Generation and Engagement

## **Catamount Club Annual Support**

For Fiscal Year 2022, the Catamount Club has received *\$1,875,425* in total support of WCU Athletics. This includes *\$1,272,372* in support of the Catamount Scholarship Fund, which is used for annual scholarship support. The overall total of financial support received through new gifts and commitments totals *\$2,463,025*.

## **Ticket Sales**

- ▶ For the 2021-22 season, total ticket revenue finished at \$293,684.43
- ▶ WCU finished 25<sup>th</sup> in the country in home football attendance averaging 9,824 this past season.

## **Sponsorships**

- ▶ It was an historic season for sponsorship sales as we signed \$514,287 in revenue in FY 22.
- ▶ During FY22, Athletics announced the two largest sponsorships in the department's history: Ingles and Harris Regional Hospital
- ► Corporate revenue sales were \$100,000 more than the previous record set in FY 19.
- ▶ New for the 2021-22 academic year is sponsored content. Army sponsored select baseball content throughout the season. Looking to 2022-23, we will continue the agreement with Army while adding Top Plays of the Week sponsored by the Book Store and First Bank is sponsoring content related to the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Title IX. We will continue the partnership with Stanberry Insurance for our Facebook Live features.
