

- Support robust programing in our offices of Intercultural Affairs and Residential Living


















- 1. Whether your concern is about behavior on campus, a specific student's wellness, or a general comment about university processes or procedures, you can find our reporting forms by scanning the QR code here or visit dsa.wcu.edu/report to get started.
- 2. Select your report type and complete as much information as you can. Be as detailed as possible.
- 3. Attach any documents that you feel are relevant to the incident you are reporting, such as photos, videos, screenshots of text messages, etc.
- 4. Our caring staff will take it from here! We will follow up appropriately on every report.

**NOTES:** Confused about what kind of report to submit? Do your best! As long as we get the information, we will route it appropriately. Under most circumstances, WCU staff cannot disclose any information about a case after a report has been submitted. We may not be able to keep your identity anonymous.
