

## Western Carolina University 2025, 2026, 2027, & 2028 Holiday Schedule

The State Human Resources Commission permits educational institutions to adopt a holiday schedule that differs from the state-wide schedule in order to meet operational needs of the campuses. Institutions may not grant additional paid holidays beyond the 12 days authorized by the General Assembly. The 2025, 2026, 2027, & 2028 holiday schedule for Western Carolina University will be as follows:

\*The holidays at Christmas are obtained by combining the Memorial Day and Veterans' Day holidays with the three holidays given for Christmas. To allow for an extended winter closing in 2025, the University will remain closed two additional days on Thursday, December 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025 and Friday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026. To allow for an extended winter closing in 2026, the University will remain closed one additional day on Thursday, December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026. To allow for an extended winter closing in 2027, the University will remain closed one additional day on Friday, December 31<sup>st</sup> 2027. No additional days will be required for 2028.

FLSA exempt leave earning employees may account for time on these dates by charging the hours to vacation leave, bonus leave or personal observance leave (if available) or leave without pay. FLSA non-exempt employees may charge the hours to vacation leave, bonus leave or personal observance leave (if available) or compensatory time if eligible. The Smart Time cascading program will adjust leave based on current program rules. As always, compensatory time is charged before personal leave accounts.

Permanent and probationary SHRA, FLSA non-exempt employees who are required to work on a designated University holiday will be paid straight time plus holiday premium pay equal to one-half of their regular straight-time hourly rate for the hours worked on these holidays. In addition, they will be given compensatory time off equal to the holiday hours worked. Hourly employees and those on temporary staff appointments receive straight-time pay plus a premium of one-half straight-time pay for work on designated University holidays, but they are not given compensatory time off.

To allow for an extended winter closing in 2030, the University will remain closed two additional days on Monday, December 30<sup>th</sup>, 2030 and Tuesday, December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2030. To allow for an extended winter closing in 2031, the University will remain closed two additional days on Wednesday, December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2031 and Friday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2032.

FLSA exempt leave earning employees may account for time on these dates by charging the hours to vacation leave, bonus leave or personal observance leave (if available) or leave without pay. FLSA non-exempt employees may charge the hours to vacation leave, bonus leave or personal observance leave (if available) or compensatory time if eligible.
