Other Requirements:

- Birth-Kindergarten Licensure students must earn a C or above in all BK and BKSE courses.
- The requirements for **continuing in the B-K licensure program** include 1) a GPA of at least 2.75 on WCU hours attempted; 2) behavior which adheres to the code of ethics of the profession and the North Carolina BK Standards; and 3) satisfactory participation in the required professional early field experiences, which are prerequisite to internship.
- Birth-Kindergarten Licensure students are responsible for all information posted on the BK Support Site, BK handbook and WCU catalog.
- **Note: Many BK and BKSE courses have some level of field experience requiring additional time beyond class meetings and assignments. Consider time for field experiences when planning your schedule**
