Other Requirements:

- Birth-Kindergarten Licensure students must earn <u>a C or above in all BK and BKSE courses</u>.
- The requirements for continuing in the B-K licensure program include 1) a GPA of at least 2.75 on WCU hours attempted; 2) behavior which adheres
 to the code of ethics of the profession and the North Carolina BK Standards; and 3) satisfactory participation in the required professional early field
 experiences, which are prerequisite to internship.
- Birth-Kindergarten Licensure students must successfully complete edTPA
- Birth-Kindergarten Licensure students are responsible for all information posted on the BK Support Site, BK handbook and WCU catalog.
- No courses may be taken during the semester of BK 483.
- No more than one course may be taken with BK 473.
- No courses may be taken in the summer between BK 473 and BK 483.

Note: Many BK and BKSE courses have some level of field experience that requires additional time beyond class meetings and assignments. Consider time for field experiences when planning your schedule.

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
