Students seeking admission to the Elementary Education Second Degree Program and initial licensure must already hold a BS or BA degree from an accredited institution. Bachelor's degrees from within the UNC system will waive Liberal Studies requirements. Degrees from out of state institutions will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. Students admitted to the second-degree program are not required to take the PRAXIS Core exam and will not need to declare a second academic concentration. However, while enrolled in the program, all students must maintain a 2.75 GPA or better to remain in good standing.
