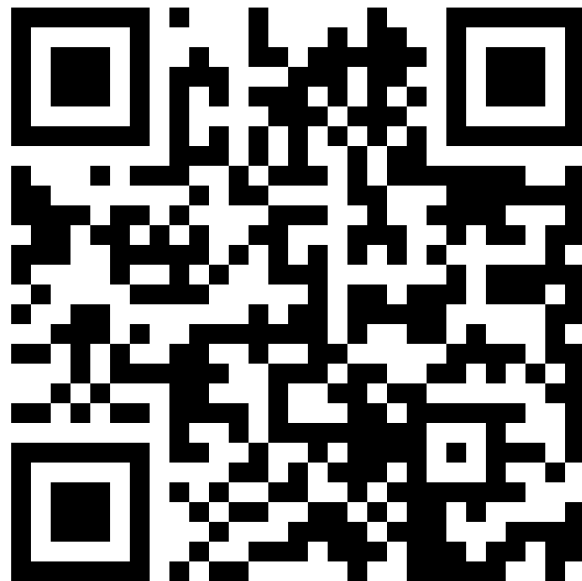

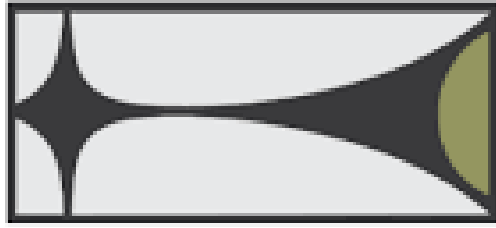

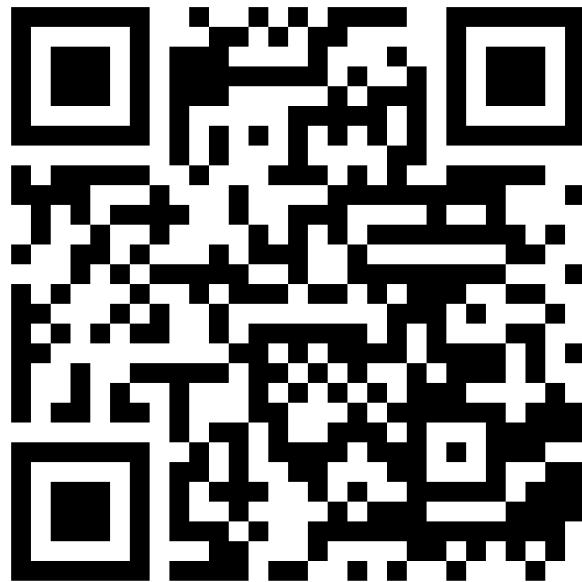

Established by statute in 1983, the North Carolina General Assembly established the Office of Guardian ad Litem Services as a division of the North Carolina Administrative Office of the Courts. Pursuant to G.S. 7B-601, when a petition alleging abuse or neglect of a juvenile is filed in district court, the judge appoints a volunteer GAL advocate and an attorney advocate to provide team representation to the child. GAL child advocates are trained, supervised, and supported by Program Staff in each county of the state. A team of GAL attorney advocates, volunteers, and staff provide legal and best interests advocacy to North Carolina children who are alleged by a department of social services.

Black Mountain Academy uses a well rounded model that we implement with students called a Personal Growth Plan. Each student's Core Team works on individualized goals aimed at progress in all areas of their lives. A student's Core Team is made up of their therapist, a lead teacher, and a lead residential coach. The Core Team collaborates with each student and their family to craft goals aimed at their personal growth in each of our Six Core Competencies. Along the way, these goals are routinely assessed and revised as a student progresses through their Personal Growth Plan. Through hard work, compassionate support, collaboration with parents, and healthy accountability, students at Black Mountain Academy grow in each of the Six Core Competencies throughout their journey with us.

Camp Lakey Gap is a week-long residential camp for autistic campers. We serve both children and adults, grouped together by age and assigned to different weeks. Our staff are trained to incorporate evidence-based strategies for supporting people with autism into all elements of our program. At Camp Lakey Gap, we offer our staff an incredible opportunity for professional and personal development. Many of our staff are college students pursuing degrees in fields like special education, recreation therapy, occupational therapy, psychology, and other related fields. 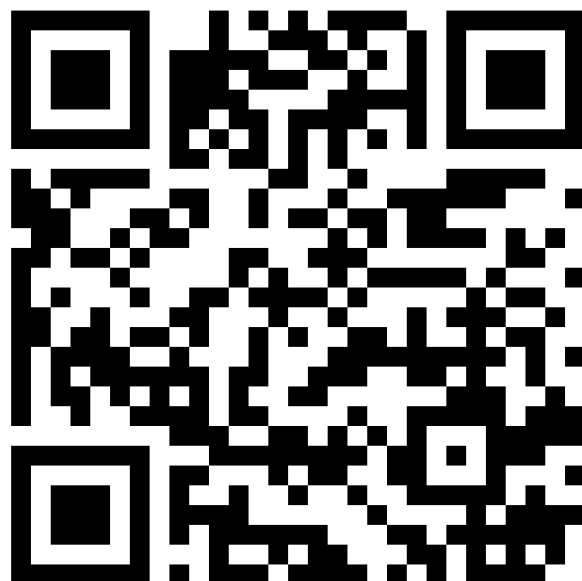
