Classes are held at WCU's Main Campus in Cullowhee and at WCU's Biltmore Park Instructional Site in south Asheville. Most classes are face-to-face with full time WCU Department of Social Work faculty; some classes are taught online, in a hybrid online/face-to-face format, or in both locations simultaneously using synchronous streaming technology. Adjunct faculty teach electives related to their field of full-time practice.
