- Introductions
- College of Education and Allied Professions Presentation – Kim Winter
 - Additional course fee in final semester for edTPA
 - Test used to assess teachers to see if they are ready to become teachers
 - Required to pursue teacher licensure
 - Difficult for students to pay for fees in addition to tuition and fees, there are a lot for teachers in the last two years
 - Many in the last semester
 - One other school has requested a fee from students to cover the cost
 - This is a new fee in addition to the \$150 fee
 - One-time fee that students must pay
 - edTPA is currently paid by CEAP but cannot continue to pay going forward
 - Students must pay if they do not pass the exam (sections of 3)
- Residence Hall Rates
 - Utilities and debt service/mortgages are the highest expenses for residence halls
 - Personnel and auxiliary services are also paid by the residence hall fee
 - Hold reserves to help pay for construction and renovations of buildings as well as unexpected situations
 - Slowly increased housing rates with a goal to reach a place where do not have to increase
 - Decrease in standard rate for Albright/Benton
 - Increased Harrill and Judaculla to align with amenities being offered
 - Lower campus residence halls with new rates
 - Most buildings there will be no increase
