Topic: Residence Hall Room Rates, Bryant Barnett, *Executive Director of Residential Living*

- Only increase requested is Noble Hall
 - Public/Private partnership
 - Contractually agreed to 2% each year but able to negotiate 1%
- Elimination of cable in the residence halls will allow to have no increase in other residence hall rates
- Elimination of hall phones in residence halls will result in additional savings; phones will remain in the lobby
- Rates are for the term of regularly scheduled opening to regularly scheduled closing; additional days will result in an additional per diem charge

Topic: Meal Plans Proposal, Robert Walker, *Associate Vice Chancellor for Auxiliary Enterprises*

- Adjusted DB to give a little more for each plan
- All costs associated with meal plans have increased
- Proposing an average increase of 5.5%
- No reduction in service is being proposed
- DB amounts increase and meal swipes decrease for each year a student is enrolled
- Dining Committee
 - Robert Walker, Dining staff, and students meet monthly to discuss dining
